Bobbie Shafer is an accomplished tapestry and hand weaver. She will instruct participants in the basics of tapestry techniques. A simple frame loom can be used, as well as a rigid heddle or table loom. Start gathering your yarn remnants in various sizes and textures now!



This is a low-cost workshop to introduce members to tapestry weaving. Participants will become familiar with warping a loom, weaving a heading, attaching a cartoon, slit tapestry, weft interlock, horizontal stripes, diagonal shapes, vertical stripes & hatching.
